

## **Bears Paw with Claws Lap Quilt Materials and Supply Sheet**

Finished Quilt: 46" x 65"

### **Materials:**

Sewing Machine in good working order with 1/4" seam capability

Pins, Thread, Scissors

Rotary Cutter, Mat and Ruler

Iron and Portable Press Board

Acrylic or template plastic placement guide (*provided in kit*)

1/4" Steam-A-Seam (*provided in kit*)

*Yardage is based on 42" wide fabric unless otherwise indicated.*

2 2/3 yards of black fabric for blocks, border and binding

1 1/8 yards of light pink print fabric for prairie points and blocks

7/8 yards of medium pink print fabric for blocks

1 yard of floral fabric for blocks

1/4 yard of dark pink print fabric for blocks

1/4 yard of light green fabric for blocks

1/4 yard of medium green fabric for blocks

### **Pre-Workshop Instructions**

Cutting: I ***always*** have everyone pre-cut their fabric; that way we can make the best possible use of class time!

*All measurements include 1/4" wide seam allowances.*

### **From the light pink print fabric, cut:**

- 6 strips, 1 5/8" x 42"; crosscut into 128 squares, 1 5/8" x 1 5/8"
- 10 strips, 2" x 42"; crosscut into 208 squares, 2" x 2"
- 3 strips, 1" x 42"

**From the medium pink print fabric, cut:**

- 4 strips, 2 1/8" x 42"; crosscut into 64 squares, 2 1/8" x 2 1/8". Cut each square in half diagonally to yield 128 triangles.
- 7 strips, 2" x 42"; crosscut into 208 rectangles, 2" x 1 1/4". From the remaining strip, cut 4 squares, 2" x 2".
- 4 strips, 1" x 42"

**From the dark pink print fabric, cut:**

- 5 strips, 1" x 42"

**From the light green fabric, cut:**

- 4 strips, 1" x 42"

**From the medium green fabric, cut:**

- 5 strips, 1" x 42"

**From the floral fabric, cut:**

- 1 strip, 1 3/4" x 42"; crosscut into 8 squares, 1 3/4" x 1 3/4"
- 3 strips, 3" x 42"; crosscut into 32 squares, 3" x 3"
- 1 strip, 7 3/8" x 42"; crosscut into 5 squares, 7 3/8" x 7 3/8". Cut each square into quarters diagonally to yield 20 triangles.
- 1 strip, 4" x 42"; crosscut into 6 squares, 4" x 4". Cut each square in half diagonally to yield 12 triangles.
- 6 strips, 1" x 42"

**From the black fabric, cut:**

- 7 strips, 1 3/4" x 42"; crosscut into 54 squares, 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" and 32 rectangles 1 3/4" x 4 1/4".
- 4 strips, 2 1/8" x 42"; crosscut into 64 squares, 2 1/8" x 2 1/8". Cut each square in half diagonally to yield 128 triangles.
- 3 strips, 1" x 42"; crosscut into 4 rectangles, 1" x 9 1/4" and 3 rectangles, 1" x 18 1/2"
- 1 strip, 7 3/8" x 42"; crosscut into 5 squares, 7 3/8" x 7 3/8". Cut each square into quarters diagonally to yield 20 triangles.
- 1 strip, 3 3/4" x 42"; crosscut into 2 squares, 3 3/4" x 3 3/4". Cut each square in half diagonally to yield 4 triangles.
- 2 squares, 4" x 4"; cut each square in half diagonally to yield 4 triangles.
- 6 strips, 6 1/2" x 42" for border. *You may want to wait and cut this later!*
- 6 strips, 2" x 42" for binding. *You may want to wait and cut this later!*
