

Peek A Boo: Materials and Supplies Sheet

Finished Quilt: 40" x 50"

Materials:

Sewing machine in good working order, and with 1/4" stitch capability

Iron and press board

Sewing Notions: pins, scissors, thread, etc.

Acrylic or Template Plastic Placement Guide (*provided in kit*)

1/4" Steam a Seam 2 (*provided in kit*)

Yardage is based on 42" wide fabric unless otherwise indicated.

1 3/8 yards of print fabric for border and binding

1/2 yard *each* of light pink, light yellow, light blue and light green for blocks

1/3 yard *each* of medium pink, medium yellow, medium blue and medium green for prairie points

1/4 yard *each* of dark pink, dark yellow, dark blue and dark green for blocks

If choosing to fuse motifs under prairie points: enough fabric to yield 48 motifs approximately 3" wide by 1 1/2" high and approximately **1 yard of fusible web of your choice** (I used Ultra Hold-No Sew Heat and Bond)

Cutting Instructions:

From *each* of the light fabrics, cut:

- 1 strip, 5 7/8" x 42"; crosscut into 6 squares, 5 7/8" x 5 7/8". Cut each square in half diagonally to yield 12 triangles. (48 total)
- 1 strip, 6 1/4" x 42"; crosscut into 3 squares, 6 1/4" x 6 1/4". Cut each square into quarters diagonally to yield 12 triangles. (48 total)

From *each* of the medium fabrics, cut:

- 2 strips, 4 3/4" x 42"; crosscut into 12 squares, 4 3/4" x 4 3/4". (48 total)

From each of the dark fabrics, cut:

- 1 strip, 6 1/4" x 42"; crosscut into 3 squares, 6 1/4" x 6 1/4". Cut each square into quarters diagonally to yield 12 triangles. (48 total)

From the print fabric cut:

You may want to wait and cut this later. That way you can determine how wide you want your border(s) to be.

- 6 strips, 5 1/2" x 42" for border
- 5 strips, 2" x 42" for binding
